**Ages** Middle School & Secondary School Students: Ages 9-19

**Instructor(s)** 1. Riding: Equine Canada Certified instructor  
2. Stable Management: Pony Club Level A Instructor

**Activities**

- Stay at home school
- Weekends/evening equine experiences
- Sept-June 5 hours per week regular meetings (stable management + riding)
- Plus "Add on" equestrian activities. Pony Club Stable levels: D, D1, D2, C, C1. Field trips to workshops, shows, clinics: Provincial Pony Club Quiz, Prince Phillip Games, Provincial Rally
- School credits: minimum 8 credits
- Multidisciplinary

**Costs** HCBC insurance junior membership  
Academy fee (includes riding and workshops) \$3000.00/year.  
Maximum 24 students
